Grace and peace to you and may the light of Advent guide us in overcoming the darkness. The Middle East is often clouded by darkness, particularly in the regions under Israeli occupation that yearn for justice and peace.

I am writing in support of my colleague Rev. Dr. Stephen Sizer, who is a respected voice for the poor and challenges injustice across the Middle East. I have known and worked with Stephen for nearly 20 years and have the utmost respect for his writing, pastoral ministry, and his speaking around the globe on behalf of the victims of persecution and human rights violations.

I was one of examiners for his doctoral thesis on Christian Zionism and was proud to provide overwhelming approval for Stephen to receive his doctorate.

His critique of Israel's policies vs. Palestinians is specific and legitimate, and of course is never welcomed by those who strive to cover-up the abuses of power.

Stephen's voice must be safe-guarded and encouraged. His challenges are consistent with those levelled by the pre-eminent Israeli human rights organization "B'Tselem," which of course translates as "in the image of", the image of God that we are called to honour and safeguard in all human beings.

Dr. Sizer is within this tradition. I sincerely hope that you will support his mission and ministry.
