**The matters in this statement to which I refer are all within my own knowledge, except where I indicate otherwise. If anything is not within my own knowledge then I set out the source of any matters of information and belief:**

The accusation of discrimination and xenophobia are serious and need to be investigated meticulously. The suffering of Jews in Europe at the hands of anti-Semites and the Holocaust means every complaint of anti-Semitism requires to be dealt with equal measure. Having known Rev Dr Stephen Sizer for over twenty years I was shocked at the allegations but as stated above it was necessary to investigate not only the message but the content of the messenger and the sources.

To come to a conclusion on the accusation without taking into account these would be a dereliction of duty and travesty of justice. To the best of my knowledge Rev Dr Sizer has been critical of Israeli Policies towards Palestinians and its occupation. However, to conflate this as anti-Semitic is to supersede Israeli government policies over Jewishness.

Any accusation has to be clearly demonstrated and having worked, read and heard Rev Dr Sizer's I believe there will be a lack of such evidence being produced.

Rev Dr Sizer has approached the issue of Israel-Palestine with the sensitivity it requires and has been able to articulate his position free of polemics that is in public domain. It is possible this may not be acceptable to some but to the best of my knowledge is free of malicious and works to end violence for a peaceful Holy Land. In all my encounters Dr Sizer's message has been from the teachings of Jesus (pbuh), one of peace and brotherhood. He emphasises diplomacy over violence and reconciliation and forgiveness over hatred.
