I have had the honor to have Rev Stephen Sizer visit me 3 times in Egypt for teaching and preaching in the church I was pastoring (Anglican Church in Heliopolis). He would then also stay in my home for 4-5 days.

He always spoke on matters related to Biblical interpretation and matters related to Palestinian national rights etc.

Never ever have I heard him say things that could be considered antisemitic. Not in public meetings and not in private talks. Even though, in a context with Arab Christians, that would probably have been received warmly.

Rev Sizer never spoke about “Jews” in general; he never made negative statements about Jews. The only thing I heard him being critical of, was the politics of the government of Israel.

I personally am very sad and outspoken against the political course of the United Kingdom and its Brexit. But I cannot conceive that anyone would ever accuse me of being racist and “anti-British”. Likewise, I do not see anything antisemitic in the critique that Rev Sizer has of Israel’s policies.
